

**Agreement for cooperation and scholarly exchange between
the University of Łódź, Poland
and the Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University, Turkey**

With the object of promoting cooperation in academic education and research between the University of Łódź, Poland and the Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University, Turkey the following agreements is established;

Article 1

The cooperation involves „Voltammetric studies of biological active compounds and their determination in pharmaceuticals and body fluids”.

The cooperation will include activities listed below:

- collaborative research, the goal of which will be:
 - a) applying the mercury electrode catalytic and adsorptive currents,
 - b) employing reduction and oxidation processes that occur on the glassy carbon and modified electrodes,
- short term exchange of researchers and of doctoral students,
- participation in the conferences and symposiums which are organized by both parties,
- exchange of scientific publications in fields which are of interest of both parties with the goal of constant information exchange.

Article 2

Implementation of exchange or other kinds of cooperation based on this agreement shall be the concern of the Faculty of Chemistry, University of Lodz (Poland) – realization by Department of Instrumental Analysis and the Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University (Turkey) - realization by Department of Chemistry.

Article 3

The persons taking part in the exchange, before their departure to the host country, should be equipped with an individual insurance embracing costs of health treatment as well as insurance policy for unforeseen incidents.

Article 4

The plan agreed upon by cooperating Faculties shall be the basis for joint academic ventures, the costs of which shall be borne by both parties.

Article 5

Both Faculties shall seek financing of joint activities from sources available to them.

Article 6

All agreements referring to present and future intellectual rights owned by each party, as well as the respective ones that are to arise while performing this agreement, shall be governed by a separate agreement.

Article 7

This agreement is subject to revision, renewal and/or cancellation by mutual written consent.

Article 8

This agreement becomes effective upon the dates of signatures and will be valid for a period of five years. During the fourth year renewal for a following five-year period will be considered.

Article 9

This agreement is written in Polish, Turkish, English, in six originals, all of them of equal validity.
