Program Profili	: Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Graduate School of Graduate Education Department of Foreign Language Education Department of Japanese Language Teaching provides graduate level Japanese Language Teaching education, conducts research and conducts theses on this subject. The aim of this program is to educate critical scholars with advanced research skills who focus on education as well as teaching by catching up with contemporary developments.
