Agreement for Undergraduate and Graduate Student Exchange Program Between

Kansai University and Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University

Kansai University and Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University agree to an exchange program for undergraduate and graduate students based on a principle of reciprocity under the 'Basic Agreement on International Exchange Programs' Part 2 of Article 1.

Article I

- 1. Qualified students from each institution shall be considered for acceptance at the other as non-degree candidates.
- 2. Students participating in the Program shall continue as candidates for degrees of their home institutions and shall not be candidates for degrees from the host institution.

Article II

- 1. Participating students shall pursue a study plan developed in consultation with the respective home institution and which is not in conflict with the regulations of the host institution.
- 2 Each student shall take courses regularly offered at the host institution within practical reason, and which are subject to approvals from both the home and host institution.
- 3 Students participating in the Program shall be subject to the rules, regulations, and discipline of the host institution.

Article III

Both institutions shall undertake efforts to maintain reciprocity in the numbers of students exchanged and the length of their stay in each year that the exchange Agreement operates.

Article IV

Each institution shall send and accept under this Agreement up to two students in any academic year.

Article V

Duration of stay for students at both host institutions shall not exceed one year, starting normally in April or September of each academic year at both institutions.

Article VI

- 1 Students participating in the Program shall be selected by their home institution on the basis of academic excellence and a serious interest in study abroad.
- 2 Each institution agrees to supply the other with academic credentials and supporting documentation required by each institution for admission purposes as early as possible in the preceding academic year.
- It is understood that each host institution reserves the right to reject candidates if there is no study field on which they hope to engage themselves. In such cases, additional applications may be furnished for consideration by the home institution.

Article VII

Each student shall pay the applicable tuition fee to the home institution and be exempted from the payment of a tuition fee to the host institution.

2 Exchange students shall be responsible for their own expenses including accommodation costs, food, travel expenses, and health care fees.

Article VIII

The host institution shall assist the students in finding accommodation at a reasonable cost.

Article IX

Host institutions shall give advice about study programs and student life to the students and take the best possible appropriate measures for them.

Article X

- 1 Upon completion of the students' study plan, academic performance shall be evaluated according to the rules of the host institution and transcripts shall be sent directly to the appropriate office of the home institution.
- 2 The academic record which each student obtained at the host institution shall be accredited according to the rules of the home institution.

Article XI

- Each institution shall designate an appropriate person and office that has the primary function of coordinating the activities of the Program.
- 2 The designated coordinator at each institution shall stay in close contact with his/her counterpart at the other institution to assure from the outset the best possible educational experience for the exchange students.

Article XII

Both institutions shall publicize both internally and externally, as deemed appropriate, the opportunities provided by this Agreement in the institutions' regular publications, and in other ways make full information of exchange opportunities, known to interested persons.

Article XIII

- This Agreement shall be in force for five years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual consent. This Agreement shall be renewed automatically if neither institution submits a desire in writing to terminate the Agreement with one year's prior notice.
- 2 This Agreement is written in the English language and two sets made; each institution shall retain one.

This Agreement shall become effective on the day when the representatives of both institutions affix their signatures to the Agreement.

Basic Agreement on International Exchange Programs between

Kansai University and Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University

Kansai University and Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University agree to cooperate on international exchange programs.

This Agreement is to provide for the exchange of scholars, students, academic information and materials and others in the belief that the research and educational processes at our respective Universities will be enhanced and that mutual understanding between our respective scholars and students will be increased by the establishment of such exchange programs.

- 1 The Universities agree to promote the following exchange programs, based on our respective academic and educational needs.
 - (1) Exchange of scholars (professors, lecturers or researchers)
 - (2) Exchange of students (undergraduate and graduate students)
 - (3) Exchange of academic information and materials
 - (4) Exchange of periodical academic publications
 - (5) Organization of joint research programs
 - (6) Other academic exchanges to which both Universities agree
- The implementation of each exchange program based on this Agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both Universities.
- 3 Such cooperative Agreements are not intended to be legally binding documents. They are meant to describe the nature and suggest the guidelines of such cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either Institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the Agreement.
- 4 This Agreement shall be in force for five years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual consent. This Agreement shall be renewed automatically if neither institution submits a desire in writing to terminate the Agreement with one year's prior notice.
- 5 This Agreement is written in the English language and two sets made; each institution shall retain one.

This Agreement shall become effective on the day when the representatives of both Universities affix their signatures to the Agreement.
