Zhejiang Normal University (ZJNU) was established in 1956. It has consistently ranked among the top 100 universities in China. According to the 2024 US News World University Ranking, ZJNU ranks 451st globally and 55th in China's mainland.

Renowned for its academic excellence, ZJNU boasts 8 disciplines—mathematics, chemistry, engineering, materials science, environment/ecology, computer science, plant & animal science, and social sciences (general)—which are distinguished among the top 1% in the ESI ranking. Additionally, it features 20 disciplines listed as top-ranked within Zhejiang Province.

ZJNU offers a comprehensive academic curriculum, including 40 nationally recognized top courses and 4 national experimental teaching demonstration centers. With 25 colleges/schools, the university offers a diverse range of programs, encompassing 69 undergraduate majors, 11 doctoral programs in Level-1 subjects, and 27 master's programs in Level-1 subjects. Moreover, it hosts 11 postdoctoral research stations and 2 National Bases for Innovation and Introducing Talents as part of the "111 Plan".

With a student population exceeding 50,000, including over 3,600 international students from 110 countries, ZJNU fosters a vibrant multicultural environment. Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must

- be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health both mentally and physically.
- be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for bachelor's programs;
- be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs;
- be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs;
- have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 4 when applying for Chinese taught master's or doctoral programs.

Application Materials

1. Copy of Passport Home Page. (The passport should be valid beyond February 2026.)
2. Notarized Highest Degree Diploma or Pre-Graduation Certificate.
3. Academic Transcripts (from the undergraduate program onwards). Copies of academic records from first to last semester during the undergraduate, graduate (if any), and doctoral programs (if any) shall be provided. They can be in Chinese or English, but must be attached with notarized English translations if they are in foreign languages other than English.
4. Language Proficiency Certificate. Applicants for Chinese-taught programs must submit valid HSK reports in accordance with the corresponding Chinese proficiency requirements. Applicants for other language-taught programs shall provide relevant language proficiency certificates according to the universities' requirements, like IELTS or TOFEL report.
5. Acceptance Letter. Doctoral applicants must provide a supervisor's acceptance letter.
6. A study plan proposal. A study plan written in Chinese or English shall contain more than 1,000 characters or words; the proposal of a doctoral student shall be signed by the applicant's Chinese supervisor.
7. Recommendation letters. Two letters of recommendation (written only in Chinese or English) from professors or associate professors shall be submitted. These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth, as well as the cooperation between the supervisors or the exchange between universities both in China and abroad.
8. Personal Works. Applicants could submit their own works through "Example of Art/Other Supporting Documents" in the system.
9. Foreigner Physical Examination Form. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Results are valid for six months.
10. No Criminal Record (Valid for 6 months).
