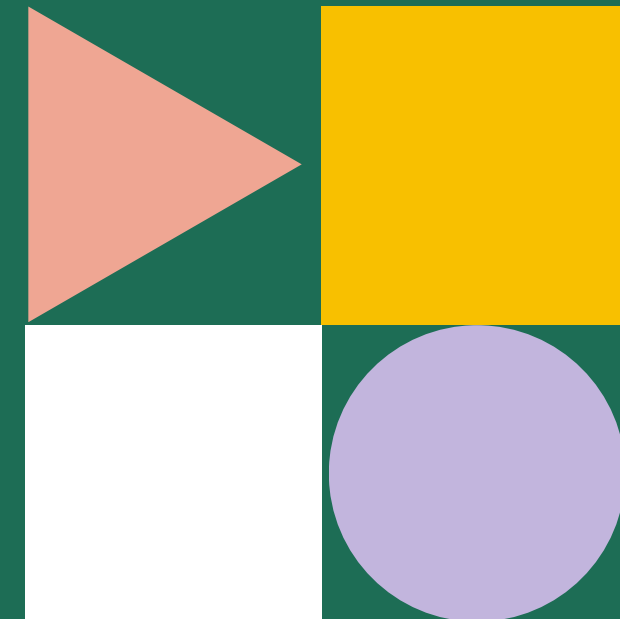

University

Zhejiang Normal University (ZJNU) was established in 1956. It has consistently ranked among the top 100 universities in China. According to the 2024 US News World University Ranking, ZJNU ranks 451st globally and 55th in China's mainland.

Renowned for its academic excellence, ZJNU boasts 8 disciplines—mathematics, chemistry, engineering, materials science, environment/ecology, computer science, plant & animal science, and social sciences (general)—which are distinguished among the top 1% in the ESI ranking. Additionally, it features 20 disciplines listed as top-ranked within Zhejiang Province.

ZJNU offers a comprehensive academic curriculum, including 40 nationally recognized top courses and 4 national experimental teaching demonstration centers. With 25 colleges/schools, the university offers a diverse range of programs, encompassing 69 undergraduate majors, 11 doctoral programs in Level-1 subjects, and 27 master's programs in Level-1 subjects. Moreover, it hosts 11 postdoctoral research stations and 2 National Bases for Innovation and Introducing Talents as part of the "111 Plan".

With a student population exceeding 50,000, including over 3,600 international students from 110 countries, ZJNU fosters a vibrant multicultural environment. International graduates from ZJNU are influential figures across various sectors worldwide, contributing significantly to politics, economy, culture, education, and more.

ZJNU provides state-of-the-art facilities such as libraries, laboratories, gymnasiums, hospitals, and supermarkets, enhancing the overall student experience. Situated on a picturesque campus, ZJNU offers an ideal environment for living and studying.

Prioritizing internationalization, ZJNU has cultivated partnerships with over 280 universities in more than 60 countries and regions. Notably, it established the Chinese-foreign cooperative education institute in China, exemplifying its commitment to global academic collaboration and exchange.

The School

The School of Mathematical Sciences, with a history of over 60 years, is one of the university's earliest departments. It comprises four divisions: Fundamental Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Discrete Mathematics, and Interdisciplinary Mathematics. The school offers doctoral and master's programs in the first-level discipline of mathematics.

THREE KEY STRENGTHS:

TOP MATHEMATICS DISCIPLINE

The school's mathematics discipline is the strongest among provincial universities, ranking in the **top 0.18% globally** in ESI, rated **A level** by Times Higher Education, **39th globally (6th domestically)** by US News, and **51-75 globally (7th nationally, and 1st in Zhejiang Province)** in the 2024 Shanghai Ranking's Global Ranking of Academic Subjects .

EXCEPTIONAL FACULTY

The school has over 100 faculty members, including **36 professors, 39 doctoral supervisors, and 85 master's supervisors**. It hosts internationally renowned scholars, such as European Academy of Sciences academician J. Neseřil, and organizes **10+** major conferences annually, with **280** scholar exchanges each year.

OUTSTANDING RESEARCH ACHIEVEMENTS

In the past five years, faculty have published **600+** high-impact journal papers, undertaken **60+** National Natural Science Foundation projects, and authored **10+** textbooks and monographs. The school's journal, Journal of Nonlinear Modeling and Analysis, is indexed in Scopus and recognized as a Tier 3 journal by the Chinese Mathematical Society.
