

02. METHODOLOGY

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Sustainability Report has been prepared with reference to Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) standards to ensure global comparability. In addition, it presents ÇOMU's significant economic, social and environmental impacts and contributions in line with the UN SDGs.

The data obtained from academic staff through the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Activity/Event Entry Form published on the website of <u>Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Sustainability Coordination</u> <u>Office</u> were used in the report. In addition, information was requested from the administrative and academic units of the university through the <u>University Information Management System (UIMS)</u>, and this information and data were also used in the report. News and event announcements published on the Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University website were also utilized in the reporting process. In our University, which uses the <u>Academic Data Management System (AVESIS)</u>, it is possible to monitor activities such as publications, theses, projects, courses, participation in congresses and symposiums, organizations, awards, editorships, art activities, research groups, visual activities carried out by our university researchers within the relevant scope with the United Nations (UN) SDG symbols on a yearly basis. However, it was not possible to obtain complete data from academic staff either through the activity entry form or the AVESIS system. Therefore, additional internet sources were scanned. As much as possible, the report includes all activities related to sustainability and the UN SDGs. As of next semester, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University is committed to publishing a sustainability report every year; therefore, this report will serve as a guide for future reports by presenting the current situation.

02.1. Basic Documents

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University's 2024 - 2028 Strategic Action Plan, 2023 Annual Plan, ÇOMÜ Climate Action Plan, Gender Equality Plan, Quality Assurance Policy, Management System Policy, Education Policy, Research Policy, Social Contribution Policy, Internationalization Policy, Sustainability Policy constitute the main documents of this report.





Figure 8. a-b:Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Education and Training Programmes



Academic Staff Distribution




Figure 10. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University academic staff distribution

DISTRIBUTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF




Figure 11. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University administrative staff distribution




Figure 12. Distribution of international students at Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University




Figure 13. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University international agreements and student distribution

04.MANAGEMENT

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, established in the 1992-1993 academic year, has a total of 37 educational units as of 2023, including a Graduate School, 21 faculties, 3 schools, and 13 vocational schools. At the same time, there are 37 research and application centers. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University offers a total of 443 programs, including 104 undergraduate programs, 97 associate degree programs, 133 thesis master's programs, 27 non-thesis master's programs, 13 distance learning non-thesis master's programs, 66 doctoral programs, and 3 proficiency in art programs.

The language of education at our university is Turkish. There are also programs in German, Japanese and English within the university. Our university has bilateral agreements with 106 universities from 39 different countries. In addition, as of May 2024, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University became a member of the European Network of Social Authorities (ENSA)

04.1. Management Structure

The top management of the University consists of the Rector, the University Board of Directors and the University Senate. The University Board of Directors consists of the Rector, Vice Rectors, Deans and three elected members and the University Senate consists of the Rector, Vice Rectors, Deans, representatives elected by the Faculty Management and the Director of the Institute. Detailed information on the decision-making and operational actions of the Senior Management can be obtained from the <u>legislation of the Council of Higher Education (YÖK)</u>.

All activities of our university are carried out in accordance with the Civil Servants Law No. 657, the Budget Law of the relevant year, the Public Procurement Law No. 4734, the Public Financial Management and Control Law No. 5018 and the relevant regulations and directives issued based on the authority granted by them. The list of laws and regulations regarding the functioning of universities is available on the <u>website</u> of the Council of Higher Education. In addition, the regulations and directives of our university can be accessed from the <u>website of our University</u>.

In accordance with the aim of designing, developing and monitoring these processes in accordance with the determined work schedule with a focus on continuous improvement of all academic or administrative actions carried out at the University, the <u>Quality Development and Institutional Monitoring Coordinatorship</u> carries out its activities under the Rectorate in order to contribute to the Quality Assurance Commission of our University, to ensure that the internal quality assurance, program accreditation and institutional accreditation studies of our University are carried out, to carry out all field studies and correspondence in this direction, to organize the necessary meetings, training and internal audit activities.

In its 30th year, our university was deemed worthy of receiving <u>Institutional Accreditation</u> based on the decision taken at the Higher Education Quality Board meeting on April 27, 2022.

04.2. Sustainability Management

Established at Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University in 2023, the <u>Sustainability Office Coordinatorship</u> aims to promote sustainability among all university stakeholders and units and to develop innovative solutions that focus on sustainable development goals. In line with the mission of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University to be a pioneering university contributing to science, technology, arts, sports and culture, the <u>Sustainability</u> <u>Office Coordinatorship</u> guides the creation and implementation of policies and strategies in accordance

with sustainability principles in all university units. The Coordinatorship Commission consists of faculty members from different disciplines such as Urban Regional Planning, Public Health, Environmental Engineering, Computer Engineering, Landscape Architecture, Public Administration, Geography, Biology, Business Management, Food Processing and Foreign Trade departments. The Sustainability Office Coordinatorship organizes Sustainability Workshops to create a culture of sustainability on campus.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University's <u>Sustainability Policy</u> promotes sustainability practices while integrating environmental, economic and social principles into decision-making processes and institutional activities. It is a fundamental principle to ensure the continuity of awareness of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals in education, research and development, social contribution and administrative activities. The University's sustainability policy also includes strengthening University-Public-Public-Industry-NGO collaborations for sustainability practices, responsible resource use to reduce water and carbon footprint, energy efficiency, waste and water management, and conducting green campus studies. The Sustainability Office Coordinatorship coordinates these efforts and is responsible for developing policies and managing actions related to the 13th Sustainable Development Goal "Climate Action".

It is aimed to realize Green Transformation and Digital Transformation as twin transformations within our university. In this context, efforts are being made to expand digitization efforts at our university; in this direction, the Digital Transformation Office Coordinatorship was established within Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University in order to reshape the business processes and ways of doing business with digital technologies in line with the impact of technological developments on the business world and society. The office continues its duties with Digital University, Artificial Intelligence, Big Data and Cyber Security Units. Digitalization efforts have been accelerated at our university. Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Digitalization R&D Unit produced a highly accurate 3D model of Terzioglu Campus. Within the scope of the work carried out, the 3D campus model, which forms the basis of planned campus information system, energy management, energy use efficiency, smart campus, green campus, green campus, green building and ecological sustainability projects in the long term, was made available to our internal and external stakeholders with a user-friendly interface on our university's website. Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University uses MS Teams as a digital platform. Training, online meetings and lessons in extraordinary situations (earthquake, pandemic, etc.) are held through this platform. In addition, a Green Transformation Coordinatorship was established to realize green transformation on campus. The coordinatorship is responsible for the green transformation process of our university as well as the coordination of all activities that interact with industrial organizations and the city within the scope of green transformation.

04.3. Management of Outputs

Sustainability Office Coordinatorship was established in 2023. The Sustainability Office Coordinatorship collects and evaluates sustainability-related information from units and student clubs through its website. The Sustainability Office Coordinatorship Management classifies and evaluates this data and presents it to the senior management. The outputs obtained from the activities carried out by the Sustainability Office Coordinatorship are presented to the Quality Office, enabling the necessary improvements to be made.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University aims to train qualified human resources who are productive, entrepreneurial, innovative, sensitive to the environment and social problems, and respectful to human rights. In this context, it has adopted the principle of developing student-oriented education, increasing the academic competence, quality and capacity to conduct effective research of the human resources it trains, increasing the level of satisfaction in education and training activities, continuously improving education programs, establishing a relationship between education programs and research activities, developing internationalization efforts by increasing bilateral cooperation agreements with our university and

universities abroad, increasing the number of international students, increasing the number of distance education programs and courses, and making education and training opportunities accessible to all students. Faculty members have to define the role of courses in meeting the teaching objectives and program outcomes. In addition, the Bologna Process Coordinatorship carries out activities such as making updates to adapt to changing conditions in the national and international arena, monitoring and reporting the creation of success indicators in achieving the planned strategies and policies, developing course information forms and reflecting them in practice. A survey is conducted for each course at the end of the semester via ÜBYS. Programs review their educational objectives with internal and external stakeholders and make necessary improvements. For performance evaluation, a questionnaire is sent to graduates at certain periods after graduation to measure expected educational goals.AVESIS platform, which was developed in order to measure and evaluate performance and to create a sustainable quality assurance system, is used for performance evaluation in our institution. Student, academic and administrative staff and stakeholder satisfaction surveys are conducted and the feedback collected is evaluated and improvement efforts are made. The results of 2023 internal stakeholder satisfaction surveys are given in the table. Stakeholder satisfaction surveys and the Campus 7/24 Wish, Suggestion and Improvement System are operated systematically and used effectively to improve processes (Table1).

Alumni meetings are held to receive feedback from graduates. A <u>Career and Alumni Relations</u> <u>Coordinator</u> was established to better manage the process. An <u>alumni communication system</u> was also established.





04.4. Students in Management

The <u>Dean of Students' Office</u>, which continues its activities in our university, was established in order to enable students to participate in administrative decisions and to communicate their demands and suggestions to senior management more easily. With the established <u>Student Senate</u>, it is aimed to ensure the participation and contribution of students as internal stakeholders in education, training, quality and accreditation processes, to establish effective communication between the senior management of the university and the students, to convey the expectations, problems and requests of the students to the senior management, to help meet and develop the educational, health, sports and cultural needs of the students, to carry out studies to ensure student satisfaction, to convey the decisions taken on strategic issues concerning the whole university to the Dean of Students to be proposed to the University Executive Board and the Senate. With the <u>Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Quality Assurance Directive</u>, a Student Quality Commission consisting of student representatives, student club representatives, foreign student representatives and disabled student representatives was established (Article 11). The Rectorate Quality Assurance Commission and the Internal Stakeholder Advisory Board, as well as the Unit Quality Assurance

Commissions of all academic units other than application and research centers, include at least one student representative member in order to ensure student participation in quality processes.

In accordance with the provisions of the directive, the student representative in the <u>Sustainability Office</u> <u>Coordination Commission</u> of our university takes part due to <u>their duty</u> as the President of the Sustainability Club.

Students' wishes and requests are communicated to the management through the Dean of Students' Office and Student Senates. In addition, thanks to the <u>Campus 7/24</u> system launched at our University, students can communicate their suggestions and improvement requests to the management. In addition, students have the <u>opportunity to create their own menus</u> with surveys that will be renewed every week in the cafeterias.

04.5. Reporting Concerns and Requests to Management

https://destek.comu.edu.tr address is used for Student Affairs and ÜBYS Technical Support requests. In this context, support is provided on information security, computer technical support, E-signature, e-mail, wireless network, licensed software, ÜBYS support, distance education, web pages and management. Thanks to the Campus 24/7 system launched at our university, students, academic and administrative staff can convey their thanks, suggestions and improvement requests to the relevant unit. Requests are evaluated within the framework of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Rectorate Quality Management System, answered by the relevant unit managers or responsible people, and the process is followed.

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05. ECONOMIC IMPACT

The university's financial system is structured in accordance with <u>national legislation</u>. The university's income and expenses are managed on the basis of items related to the Central Government Budget Law. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University's income and expense distributions are available in the <u>2023 financial</u> <u>tables</u> published online. As a state university, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University uses the budget responsibly. In addition, information on financial performance is provided in the reports on the <u>COMÜ -</u> <u>Quality Coordination - Quality Assurance Commission page</u>.

Our university makes the necessary expenses for the quality and program accreditation of its academic and administrative units. In 2023, the necessary service procurement was carried out to obtain the ISO 9001 Quality Management System, ISO 14001 Environmental Management System, ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System, ISO 22000 Food Safety Management System certificates of Dardanos Campus Economic Enterprise and the ISO 9001 Quality Management System, ISO 10002 Customer Satisfaction Management System and ISO 21001 Educational Institutions Management System certificates of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Health Culture and Sports Department. In addition, payments were made for academic program accreditation at our university. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University supports income-generating activities that are critical to increasing personnel income, especially through activities such as Technopolis, projects, consultancy services, etc.

The employees of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, which is a State University, are public personnel and their salaries and annual salary increases are determined by the government. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University's employment practices are also accessible online. Information regarding contract personnel recruitment is provided via the website of our <u>University's Personnel Department</u>. In accordance with Article 4/B of the Civil Servants Law No. 657, the preliminary evaluation list of applications made for the Contract Personnel recruitment announcement is announced on the website. As announced, the Preliminary Evaluation starts with the candidate who has the highest KPSS score. While the number of main candidates to be approved and the number of substitutes twice the number of quotas (ten times for Protection and Security Officers) are determined, the applications of those who do not meet the conditions at this stage are rejected. As a result of this process, the remaining applications are not evaluated. Candidates whose applications are rejected are given the opportunity to learn the reasons for rejection by logging into the https://ilan.comu.edu.tr/ website with their own username and password. The candidate also has the right to object to the announced lists via their own e-mail address.

05.1. Responsible Purchasing

Recruitments at our university are made within the framework of the savings circular. Within the framework of the Climate Action Plan, our university plans to prioritize companies and service providers that prioritize local producers, prevent/reduce waste generation, and take sustainable and responsible purchasing principles into consideration.

05.2. Human Resources

According to 2023 data, the total number of academic staff at Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University is 1987. When the distribution of academic staff by title is examined, it is seen that the university employs 356 professors, 304 associate professors, 494 faculty members, 428 lecturers, and 405 research assistants; There are a total of 2674 administrative staff, and approximately 55% of this staff is female and 45% is male.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University (ÇOMÜ) ranks 2nd among 255 applications in the Erasmus academic staff teaching mobility budget. The applications submitted by higher education institutions and accredited national mobility consortia within the scope of Erasmus+ KA131 (Student and Staff Mobility in Higher Education) activity in the 2023 application period by the Turkish National Agency were evaluated by the Turkish National Agency and the results were announced. According to these results, our University stood out as the 2nd university that was entitled to the highest budget within the scope of Erasmus Teaching Mobility by benefiting from 376 existing agreements with 175 universities in 30 different European countries. In addition, our University was entitled to the 42nd highest budget in Student Learning Mobility and won the highest grant right in all Erasmus categories within the Thrace Universities Union.

06. SOCIAL IMPACT

06.1. Peace and Justice

As a state university, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University accepts students based on the University Entrance Exam results. Postgraduate student admissions are also transparently carried out by the Graduate Education Institute. Therefore, there is no discrimination in student admissions. Our university observes the rule of law in all its activities and ensures transparency in decision-making processes. Adherence to ethical values, respect for people and differences, justice and merit, accessibility, transparency and accountability, inclusive education approach, and quality-oriented institutional culture are among our basic principles.

Academic freedom is secured through the Ethical Behavior Principles of the Council of Higher Education. In the Higher Education Law No. 2547, disciplinary and penal matters are specified in Article 53 and in Article 4.h, "Discrimination based on language, race, color, gender, political thought, philosophical belief, religion and sect in the performance of duty, and acting in a manner that targets the benefit or harm of individuals by acting contrary to the requirements of duty" are regulated as practices that require punishment. For administrative personnel disciplinary procedures, the "Disciplinary Affairs Bureau" is responsible for ensuring that the disciplinary procedures of administrative personnel are carried out and followed up in accordance with the relevant legislation. Disciplinary processes are carried out meticulously. With the 24/7 system implemented in our university, academic and administrative personnel can convey all kinds of wishes, suggestions and comments regarding improvements to the management.

As a state university, Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University complies with all laws of the Republic of Turkey. In this context, it complies with all relevant laws such as the Occupational Health and Safety Law No. 6331, the Labor Law No. 4857, the Law on the Protection of Personal Data No. 6698, the Law on the Trial of Civil Servants and Other Public Officials No. 4483, the Law on Higher Education No. 2547, and the Law on the Right to Information No. 4982. The Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University https://mevzuat.comu.edu.tr/ address contains documents such as laws, regulations, directives, policies, procedures and principles. In line with the Constitution and laws, it is mandatory to implement practices that eliminate everything related to forced labor, modern slavery, human trafficking and child labor, and to recognize worker rights that provide job security befitting human dignity. The salaries of all academic and administrative staff are determined and fixed in line with state policies. Our university publishes employment practices, conditions and the functioning of the university on its website. Compliance with laws and regulations is carried out in accordance with the Principles of Turkish Higher Education Institutions. In addition, Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University's personnel procedures and Gender Equality Plan are also accessible online. Staff have the right to become members of a union, and the number of unions and member information at our university are included. In this way, staff have the opportunity to convey their problems to the management and make their voices heard.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University organizes various in-service trainings in order to support the development of academic and administrative staff, inform them about their rights and responsibilities, and provide information about the steps to be taken in the face of problems. <u>In-service training</u> provided in 2023 are given in the table below. It also directs staff to receive training through the <u>Human Resources Office of the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey Distance Education Portal</u>. These trainings include Disciplinary Investigation Training, KVKK Training, Law No. 3071 on the Use of the Right to Petition, Law No. 4982 on Information, Law No. 657 on Civil Servants, Risk Assessment Training, Gender Equality in the Workplace

Based on Human Rights, Mobbing (Psychological Violence in the Workplace), Artificial Intelligence Training in Working Life, Public Ethics and Principles of Ethical Behavior for Public Officials.

06.2. Equality

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University carries out various studies for all students, academic and administrative staff in order to increase social performance and ensure equality.

Processes aimed at developing the competencies of academic staff are systematically planned, implemented, monitored and developed at our university. Educational activities aimed at developing the competencies of academic staff are carried out through in-service trainings held within the Continuous Education Center (SEM), In-Service Training Branch Directorate of the Human Resources Department, Distance Education Application and Research Center (ÇOMUZEM), Scientific Research Application and Research Center (ÇOBİLTUM) and academic units.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University organizes promotion and title change exams in order to support the career development of administrative staff, increase the competencies of staff and provide equal opportunities. The university provides institutional quality assurance by organizing internal stakeholder meetings and in-service training programs for staff. These programs support the professional development of staff and aim to create a working environment based on the principle of equality. In-Service Trainings are organized by the In-Service Training Branch Directorate of the Personnel Department within the scope of the "In-Service Training Procedure" and In-Service Training Directive. Within this scope, 30 in-service training activities were carried out by the In-Service Training Branch Directorate of evaluate the in-service trainings, the Unit Manager Evaluation Survey and the Participant Evaluation Survey were developed by the Quality Assurance Commission Measurement and Evaluation Advisory Board in cooperation with the relevant branch directorate and started to be implemented as of November 2023. When the results of the 2023 Administrative Personnel Satisfaction Survey on in-service training are examined, it is determined that the highest score and satisfaction level from the "provided self-development/in-service training-orientation opportunities" is 81.6%.

06.2.1. Equality and Accessibility for Students

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University provides support through the <u>International Student Office</u> to inform international students about issues such as equivalence and residence permit in application and registration procedures.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University organizes social and cultural activities through various student clubs and societies. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University has <u>76 student clubs</u> that encourage social learning and self-learning and have a wide range of social and scientific activities. These clubs encourage active participation of students according to their interests and strengthen social solidarity. For example, many clubs such as social responsibility club and sustainability club contribute to the development of social skills of students.



Social Transcript is an official record of a student's extracurricular activities such as clubs, societies, volunteering and leadership roles at the university. With the <u>Social Transcript</u>, it is a document that shows employers not only the academic skills of a student but also the social and personal skills during their university education (Figure 14)..

<u>The Psychological Counseling Guidance Unit (PDRB)</u>, which started operating under the Health, Culture and Sports Department in 2004, carries out many studies in order to provide individual and group psychological assistance, organize developmental and educational programs and evaluate the work done in order to help Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University students get to know themselves, realize their potential and talents, use and develop them, solve their problems, realize themselves and achieve a balanced adaptation to their environment. <u>The Student Affairs Department</u> provides support for students in summer school and course selection processes. It also provides the necessary infrastructure and coordination for students from different universities to take courses. ÇOMÜ's <u>Erasmus Unit</u> provides various support services for students in application and other processes. The <u>International Student Office</u> provides guidance and support services to facilitate residence permit, equivalence and other administrative procedures for foreign students. This office assists students in many matters from registration to placement processes. ÇOMÜ supports foreign students in learning Turkish through <u>TÖMER (Turkish Language Teaching</u>)

<u>Application and Research Center</u>). It aims to help hundreds of foreign students who come to our university, as well as Erasmus students and individuals who want to learn Turkish as a foreign language for various reasons, in language learning. In addition, students are offered language education opportunities with the foreign language school. Our university aims to help students develop their social skills, adapt to university life more easily and encourage more active participation in social activities by organizing social and cultural events.

06.2.2. Accessibility for Disabled Students

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University makes various arrangements to ensure the full participation of disabled students in their education and social life. The University Disabled Student Unit aims to identify the needs of students with special needs in terms of education, training, scholarship, administrative, physical, accommodation, social and similar areas during their education, to determine the measures to be taken to meet these needs and to offer solution suggestions to eliminate them, and to carry out the necessary arrangements in coordination with other units or departments in the university. In addition, the unit works to provide free auxiliary equipment for students with special needs who are experiencing economic difficulties. In order to ensure that all students are subject to fair and accurate measurement and evaluation, to ensure equal opportunities and to make the educational process meaningful for these students; is responsible for providing the disabled student with the necessary time, place, material, companion reader for the exams and taking the necessary precautions and making arrangements according to the differences arising from the nature of the disability. The Disabled Student Unit has prepared surveys, building observation forms, disabled student needs determination forms and published them on its website in order to meet the physical and educational needs. It determines accessibility needs thanks to these forms and surveys. In line with the data obtained from these forms, studies are carried out to eliminate accessibility problems on campus. The 2023 Disabled Coordination Unit Orientation Meeting was held at the Troia Cultural Center on Thursday, December 28, 2023, with the coordinators and unit managers in 38 units under the chairmanship of the Disabled Student Unit Coordinator, and the current situation and improvement suggestions were made.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University makes appropriate arrangements for disabled students and staff in order to increase physical accessibility on campus. These arrangements include ramps, elevators and disabled toilets at the building entrances. In addition, there are also areas suitable for wheelchair use and additional devices such as induction loop systems.



Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University's Oral and Dental Health Application Center has become the <u>first healthcare institution to</u> <u>receive an accessibility certificate</u>. In addition, the university has applied to the Barrier-Free University Flag Awards organized by the Council of Higher Education to demonstrate its commitment to accessibility (Figure 15).

There is one Braille alphabet printer and three bagtype induction loop devices to <u>provide materials to</u> <u>disabled students in accessible formats</u>. In addition, special educational materials such as audio books have been made available to our students. Petition samples and requirement determination forms are used to make the necessary arrangements in exams and courses. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University continues its work to ensure the full participation of disabled students in university life and to implement the best practices in accessibility (Figure 17, 18,19).

A <u>solfege class for children with autism</u> was established for the first time in the world as part of the 3rd Autism and Music Summer School hosted by Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University State Conservatory (<u>https://www.comu.edu.tr/haber-21788.html</u>). Organized to meet the needs of individuals with autism and related communities, to provide support and to raise awareness, and to provide free education, the "Autism and Music Summer School" was realized with the cooperation of Çanakkale Governorship, Çanakkale Municipality, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, ÇOMÜ Faculty of Education, ÇOMÜ State Conservatory, Music Application and Research Center, Çanakkale Music and Performing Arts Development Association, Kütahya Fine Arts Association, Youth and Sports Provincial Directorate, ASKEV, ÇASEMDER and the support of many stakeholders.

06.3. Gender Equality

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University <u>Gender Equality Plan</u> covers the principles, strategies and measures to be taken by the university administration to create equal opportunities and secure rights and freedoms at all levels among academic and administrative staff, students and all other employees. This document, which aims to promote gender equality, has been prepared to support equal visibility in public and private spaces, women's empowerment and participation, equal distribution of social resources and opportunities, and women's access to these resources and opportunities, regardless of gender. At Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, a public university, there are no gender differences in pay scales for all employees, regardless of gender. This document commits to support male and female academic and administrative staff in parenting and caring for their family members without discrimination between men and women, not only through official leave rights, but also by showing the institutional understanding and sensitivity they may need, supporting them to share their responsibilities equally without discrimination. The <u>Children's Home and Nursery</u>, which has ISO 9001: 2015, ISO 29990: 2010, ISO 21001: 2018 quality certificates affiliated to the Economic Enterprise operating on the Terzioğlu Campus of our university, provides childcare services (Figure 19).

Efforts are made at Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University to combat sexual harassment and/or sexual assault as a form of discrimination and violence arising from gender inequality and to create a campus environment free from sexual harassment and/or sexual assault. In order to prevent sexual harassment and/or assault, security measures are taken by organizing the physical conditions of the campus, providing a sufficient number of lighting units and security guards for the safety of all individuals in all open and closed areas. In cases of sexual harassment and/or assault, it aims to carry out an effective and rapid investigation and implementation developed within the framework of the relevant disciplinary legislation (Higher Education Law No. 2547 and the relevant provisions of the Civil Servants Law No. 657). Training on "Gender Equality in the Workplace on the Basis of Human Rights" was provided through the distance learning portal on gender equality. Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University carries out projects to combat violence against women and raise social awareness. These projects include awareness-raising projects such as "Zero Tolerance in News on Violence Against Women". In addition, a panel was organized within the scope of the Scientific Research Project (BAP) on "Women's Employment in Canakkale Local Press" supported by Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University. In addition, a cooperation protocol was signed between KADEM Canakkale Provincial Representative Office and Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University. With the signed protocol, workshops and trainings will be planned and social responsibility projects will be developed in order to raise awareness of women in political, social, legal, economic, cultural life and family life, to support the intellectual and mental development of the family and the child within the scope of the program to support the development of women and young people.

06.4. Social Facilities

06.4.1. Nutrition

The Student Social Activity Center (ÖSEM), which has been in service at the Terzioğlu Campus of our university since January 2005, is a 3-storey modern unit with a total indoor usage area of 9,000 m2. There is a 1756 m2 dining hall area. The meals prepared meet 2.5/5 of the daily energy and nutritional requirements of our students, containing an average of 1200-1400 kcal and 27-33 g protein. Meal menus are prepared by the company manager, warehouse manager, chef, dietician and food engineer and submitted to the approval of the Nutrition Branch Directorate of the Department of Health, Culture and Sports. In 2023, the number of students benefiting from the Nutrition Assistance of our University is 500 (Table 2, Figure 20). In the Part-Time Status, 280 students worked.

06.4.2. Health




Figure 21. a-b-c-d-e-f: ÇOMÜ Hospital visuals

<u>Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University University Hospital</u>, one of the most important health institutions in Çanakkale and the only university hospital in the region, offers innovative health services offered by modern medicine with its expert staff and advanced technology infrastructure. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University University Hospital started to provide health services in Çanakkale Kepez district on November 12, 2008. The hospital, which started to move to its new building on the Terzioğlu Campus on March 09, 2018, accepted patients to the Emergency Department on March 11, 2018 and started to provide health services in outpatient clinics on March 12, 2018 (Figure 21-a-b-c-d-e-f). Since 2008, the hospital has assumed a great responsibility in meeting the health needs of both university members and students, city residents and residents of the surrounding provinces. ÇOMU Hospital has received the <u>Health Tourism Authorization</u> <u>Certificate</u>. In addition, ÇOMU Hospital received the "Intensive Care Nursing Certified Training Authorization" from the Ministry of Health, General Directorate of Health Services. In this context, the "Intensive Care Nursing Certified Training" certificate ceremony was held in the Conference Hall of ÇOMÜ Hospital. The training program lasted for six weeks with 120 hours of theoretical and 120 hours of practice delivered by lecturers, nurses and experts from other fields. Eighteen nurses from ÇOMU Hospital and hospitals of various provinces completed the training and were awarded their certificates.

Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Oral and Dental Health Practice and Research Center was established within the Faculty of Dentistry with the regulation published in the Official Gazette dated March 12, 2019 and numbered 30712. At the end of 2018, after the University Health Practice and Research Hospital in Kepez moved to its new building in Terzioglu Campus, the clinical infrastructure works of the Faculty of Dentistry and the center, which will provide oral and dental health services in the same building, were completed in 2021 (Figure 22). In the building, which has an area of approximately 8,500 m2, there are clinics where oral and dental health services are provided in all dentistry specialty branches as well as education and research activities. In 2021, a license application was made to the Ministry of Health and the license was obtained. The health facility, whose space and equipment deficiencies have also been eliminated, started to serve as of November 01, 2021.

Occupational Health and Safety

Within the scope of occupational health and safety, the <u>Occupational Health and Safety Coordinatorship</u> was established at our university in order to carry out activities to protect the occupational health and safety of employees and to improve occupational safety and to fulfill the requirements and sanctions in the relevant law/legislation.

06.4.3. Housing

There are <u>practices for housing allocation</u> for the benefit of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University staff (Figure 23). The university has a total of 39 lodging houses in various campuses, especially in Dardanos Campus and Gökçeada School of Applied Sciences, and in the central campus. There are also 9 guesthouses. There are a total of 11 state dormitories located around Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University campuses. Of these, 5 are for boys, 5 for girls and 1 mixed dormitory.

<u>Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Scholarship and Housing Coordinatorship</u> evaluates the housing applications made by University students to the dormitory quotas managed by the University or allocated to the University within the framework of predetermined criteria and places deemed appropriate. It can also make these evaluations through computer programs that evaluate and score the qualifications of the applicant students. Through the coordinator, it establishes communication between the academic and administrative units and the institutions and people managing the accommodation places and the students, and provides information that can contribute to the evaluation. Provides counseling and guidance to students on housing issues. Develops suggestions and methods for meeting, monitoring and evaluating housing needs. Prepares reports and comparative analyses on housing activities at regular intervals. Establishes the necessary cooperation with the Scholarship Commission.

In addition, <u>ARDES Student Dormitory</u>, a private dormitory on the Terzioğlu Campus, serves students. The dormitory has many facilities such as internet, ATM, hairdresser, market, café, fitness center, etc. All students can benefit from some of the services provided in these facilities.

06.4.4. Library

<u>Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Library and Documentation Department</u> started its activities in Anafartalar Campus on 20.10.1993 and moved to its current building with a closed area of 5.000 m² in Terzioglu Campus from the 2005-2006 academic year (Figure 24). With the additional building opened for use in 2014, it continues to serve its users with its rich printed and electronic collection with a seating area of 1000 people in a closed area of 8000 m2 and a shelf length of 17 km. With its remarkable performance, COMU Library has become the fastest growing university library in Turkey.

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Library is one of the leading research libraries in Turkey with its rich print and electronic collection as well as its physical equipment and facilities. ÇOMU libraries consist of 1 central library, 3 faculty libraries and 9 libraries:

- Central Library (Terzioglu Campus)
- COMU Biga Library (Ağaköy, Biga)
- Education Library (Anafartalar Campus)
- ÇOMÜ Theology Library (Şekerpınar Campus)
- Faculty of Medicine Library (Temporarily in the Central Library)
- District libraries (Yenice, Ezine, Bayramiç, Gökçeada, Ayvacık, Lapseki, Gelibolu, Çan, Bozcaada)


06.4.5. Culture & Arts & Sports

The Department of Health, Culture and Sports is a service unit that meets the social, cultural, nutritional and sports needs of students for the whole of the population it serves at universities, as well as an application department where applications and research are carried out in this field in order to support education and training. The aim of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Department of Health, Culture and Sports is to protect the physical and mental health of students, to protect their physical and mental health, to evaluate their leisure time according to their nutrition, study, rest and interests, to provide services that will enable them to gain new interests, to improve their social status, to develop their talents, to gain regular and disciplined study, rest and entertainment habits (Figure 25).

There are 1 conference hall and 1 congress center operating under the <u>Department of Health, Culture and</u> <u>Sports</u>. Prof. Dr. Sevim BULUÇ Auditorium located in the Troia Cultural Center on Terzioğlu Campus has a capacity of 510 people. In addition, Troia Cultural Center serves our events with four lecture halls.

Çanakkale Martyrs Campus, Faculty of Theology, İÇDAŞ Kara Yusuf Congress Center, 15 July Democracy Martyrs Conference Hall has a capacity of 1119 people and serves our events.

<u>Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Sports Union Coordinatorship</u> was established by the Senate Decision No. 18/30 dated 26.10.2023, which aims to plan and contribute to the execution of practices related to the execution and organization of sports activities within Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, to ensure that students participate in physical activities by organizing different sports activities continuously within the university, to participate in competitions in the activity calendar of the Turkish University Sports Federation, and to work to make the university campus a "SPORTS-FRIENDLY CAMPUS" by cooperating with internal and external stakeholders. Our university has hosted various events and tournaments (Figures 25, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34)




Figure 34. a-b: Marine Sciences Museum, c-d: Piri Reis Museum, e-f Earth Sciences Museum

06.5. Education and Research

ÇOMU also makes a name for itself with the practical and overseas education, foreign language, library and EU student exchange opportunities it offers to its students. Paying special attention to practical opportunities, ÇOMU provides students with the opportunity to apply the theoretical knowledge they acquire in their courses in practice with its Technopark, laboratories, application and research centers, observatory with the largest telescope in Turkey, radio and television studios, sports halls, theater stages, as well as natural application areas such as Troy, Assos and Gallipoli for history and archeology.

<u>Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Science and Technology Application Center (ÇOBİLTUM)</u> was established in 2004 and is a unit operating under the Rectorate (Figure 35a). By organizing its activities within the framework of a central organization and creating a creative and productive research environment; To develop new products and materials that have high added value and require high technology in production and design stages in a way that can serve Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, Çanakkale and its surroundings; to carry out studies in branches of science that allow research scientists to work in

interconnected and interdisciplinary fields; to respond to the needs of industrialists and entrepreneurs of the region for all kinds of products, processes and material information based on advanced technologies; to enable master's / doctoral students to carry out scientific-technological studies by using the facilities of the center and to educate, guide and train these students.

Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Experimental Research Application and Research Center (COMÜDAM) was opened on May 14, 2012. On January 31, 2013, with the decision number 079 of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, it received the Work Permit Certificate and started experimental animal production and experimental studies (Figure 35b). In addition to many master's theses, experimental processes of BAP and TÜBİTAK projects are carried out by our university staff and students from the laboratory units established within the center. Basically, the laboratory infrastructure is sufficient for many prominent topics such as the evaluation of gene expression from tissue and cell lines, wound healing, anastomosis and biochemical analyzes (WB, gel imaging, etc.). The Stem Cell Laboratory has all the necessary infrastructure for the culture and monitoring of mammalian cells (somatic cells, stem cells and cancer cells). Experimental animals such as rats, mice, rabbits and guinea pigs are raised in the center for use in scientific activities. It is possible to perform many experimental models on these animals. In this respect, the center also serves the universities in the region and offers animal experiments for many new products developed in our university's TEKNOPARK. The center also has specialized devices especially for rabbit anesthesia and monitoring. The ozone device and hyperbaric oxygen treatment cabin specially designed for experimental animals in the center offers opportunities for new approaches in the treatment of many diseases (Figures 36,37).




Figure 38. Number of courses that included "Sustainability" and related SDG keywords or were scanned from the UBYS system




Figure 42. "InSEA World Congress 2023", 4-8 September 2023 https://www.comu.edu.tr/haber-21929.html




Figure 54. Faculty of Medicine 1st International 3rd National Student Congress, 13-15 October 2023

06.6. Social Solidarity

06.6.1. ÇOMÜ Boutique

The <u>COMÜ Boutique project</u>, affiliated to the ÇOMÜ Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship, is an activity where students can meet their basic needs such as clothing, supplies, household goods, stationery, etc. free of charge. Students of our university and citizens directed to our coordinatorship by public institutions and organizations can benefit from this project. The ÇOMÜ Boutique project, which is affiliated to the ÇOMÜ Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship, defines a total of 10 clothing rights, 5 pieces in the fall semester and 5 pieces in the spring semester, based on the academic calendar. The food packages prepared by the ÇOMÜ Boutique team are delivered 1 (one) time each month after the necessary identification is presented. Household goods in the inventory are delivered to the person who requests them after presenting the necessary identification. Within the scope of the ÇOMÜ Boutique project affiliated to

the ÇOMÜ Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship, the products requested within the scope of the ÇOMÜ Boutique project can benefit from the Student ID cards issued by our university, and the citizens directed by public institutions and organizations to the coordinatorship can benefit by presenting their T.R. ID cards. Within the scope of the ÇOMÜ Boutique project under the ÇOMÜ Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship, basic needs such as clothing, supplies, household goods, stationery can be delivered via social media accounts, internal number and website (Figure 90).

06.6.2. Earthquake

Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship started to implement the "Friend in Need" project after the earthquakes that occurred in Kahramanmaras on February 6, 2023. The earthquakes of magnitude 7.7 and 7.6 in Pazarcık and Elbistan districts of Kahramanmaras affected many citizens living in 10 provinces. The team, which continued to work intensively after the disaster, sent the products to Kepez City Port to be delivered to the earthquake zone as a result of the support received. Emphasizing that the support packages included 2 pallets of clothes, 2 pallets of hand disinfectants and masks, many blankets and cleaning supplies, the ÇOMÜ Boutique team delivered many products to the earthquake zone under the coordination of AFAD. After the earthquake, two support trucks were sent in the first stage; in addition, as a result of the delivery of countless support to the COMÜ Boutique area and the coordinated work of 350 volunteer students, the third support truck was delivered to the earthquake zone under the coordination of AFAD. The COMÜ Boutique team, within the scope of the campaign, sent the third truck to the earthquake zone. support packages in the 3rd truck sent to the earthquake zone within the scope of the campaign; 9200 pieces of women's clothing, 8000 pieces of men's clothing, 5400 pieces of children's clothing, 4500 pieces of children's pants, 1330 coats, 348 packs of toilet paper, 10 heaters, 65 boxes of food, 480 blankets, 800 baby food, 790 wet wipes, 1348 packs of diapers, 2032 hygiene products, 680 packs of water, 4 packs of disposable covers, 100 electronic items, 4480 sanitary pads, 2000 scarves, berets, gloves and 1700 socks (Figure 91).

After the February 6, 2023 earthquake centered in Kahramanmaraş, the Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship continued to work in the earthquake zone without a break. The coordinatorship did not forget the earthquake zone and came together with the little ones in Hatay between November 5 - 10 within the scope of the "One Book One Letter" Project. While Coordinator Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hicran Özlem Ilgın and the Social Responsibility Project team set out to improve 2 libraries in Hatay, the project touched the hearts of citizens affected by the earthquake living in 4 schools, 2,275 students and 1 container city. In Antakya / Yüksel Kemal Behzetoğlu Anatolian High School, Hatay Akhisar 125th Year Primary School, Antakya / Sümerler Secondary School, Kırıkhan / Yunus Emre Primary School and İskenderun / Üsküdar container city, 6,000 books collected with the <u>"One Book One Letter"</u> project initiated by ÇOMU Social Responsibility Project Coordinatorship and activities were held. Within the scope of the activities, face painting, balloon activities, coloring the walls of the schools and fun activities were organized for the little ones (Figure 92).

In order to heal the wounds of the citizens affected by the disaster in the earthquake regions and reduce their suffering, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Hospital Deputy Chief Physician Dr. Lecturer. Prof. Dr. Semih Petekkaya, Deputy Chief Physician of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Hospital, Research Assistant Dr. Umut Oktay, Health Technician Fatih Sertçe, Ambulance Driver Yavuz Varlı and Burhan Çevik, <u>1 fully equipped ambulance set off to the region with medical supplies</u>. In addition, Civil Engineer Fatih Şerif Coşan and Civil Engineer Mehmet Alper Çelebi from the staff of ÇOMU Department of

Construction and Technical Affairs support the damage assessment works of the earthquake that occurred in Kahramanmaraş on February 6, 2023 and affected the surrounding provinces. Coşan and Çelebi were assigned to carry out damage assessment studies in Hatay province within the scope of Turkey Disaster Response Plan (TAMP) with the instruction of the General Directorate of Construction Works of the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change and with the approval of Çanakkale Governor's Office. As Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University ÇABA Multi-Purpose Early Childhood Education Center (ÇABAÇAM), 3 separate ÇOMU ÇABAÇAM Education Support Units, two in Adıyaman and one in Kahramanmaraş, were established for preschool children between the ages of 3-6 in two separate tent cities established in Kahramanmaraş and Adıyaman provinces, which were severely damaged by the earthquake (Figure 93).

06.6.3. Fire

On August 22, 2023, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University supported Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University at the point of social contribution in the forest fire disaster that occurred in the forest area near Kayadere Village of Çanakkale Center and threatened the Terzioğlu and Ulupınar Campuses of our university. With the action plans of the "University Crisis Desk" created, our academic and administrative staff and students worked with the principle of volunteerism at every stage of the fire disaster without the concept of working hours. Following the forest fire disaster, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University continued its efforts in the region and provided <u>blanket support</u> in the villages affected by the fire under the coordination of ÇOMÜ Boutique and sponsorship of Kolunsağ company. In this context, visits were made to Ulupınar, Yağcılar, Değirmenköy and Aşağıokçular villages. With the Black Day Friend Project 2 project, material support was provided to the teams on duty in the Çanakkale fires that occurred on July 17 and August 24.

07. ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

07.1. Supporting Biodiversity

The campuses of our university have green areas that will meet the functions of education, transportation and housing, as well as recreation functions with planned seating areas, walking paths, natural green areas and landscaping arrangements. Green areas constitute the majority of open spaces where students, lecturers and other users can engage in various activities outside working hours. Various scientific studies are carried out to identify, protect and support the biodiversity of our campuses.

Sea Life Support Program




Figure 95. a-b-c-d-e-f-g-h-i-j-k . The endangered coral reef was protected by being published in the official gazette in 2021. https://sustainability.comu.edu.tr/en/page/1-23-conservation-49.html

Rare Species on Campus: Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Terzioglu Campus has a natural flora and fauna, which has been revealed by scientific studies such as theses, papers, projects and articles in previous years. There are 566 plant taxa belonging to 113 families and 338 genera in Terzioglu Campus. 382 of the 566 taxa are naturally distributed in the area. There are a total of 4 endemic plant species unique to our country in the campus area. At the same time, there are many landscape plants on the campus within the scope of environmental regulation studies. Of the 116 landscape plant species in Terzioğlu Campus; 55 are leafy trees and shrubs, 15 are coniferous tree species, 40 are shrubs, and 6 are vines. Terzioğlu campus has a rich fauna including different amphibian and reptile species, spider, butterfly and bird species due to its different habitat and terrain structure. There are 6 species of amphibians and 16 species of reptiles within the borders of the campus. In addition, 136 spider species from 109 genera belonging to 32 families are found on the campus. In addition, there are 57 butterfly species belonging to 13 families. There are also 102 bird species belonging to 13 ordo and 36 families. On the Dardanos campus, there are 110 bird species belonging to 18 ordo and 39 families. Within the scope of the 2209-A University Students Research Projects Support Program, the project titled "Ornithofauna of Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Terzioğlu Campus", which was carried out by Ege Can DEBRELİ, a student of the Department of Biology, and advised by Prof. TOSUNOĞLU, Dr. Murat was found support. 
Figure 96. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Campus Birds

Flora

According to the on-site determinations in Terzioğlu Campus, the following plants belonging to 34 families were identified (Creating an Arboretum in ÇOMÜ Terzioğlu Campus, Prof. Dr. Füsun ERDURAN NEMUTLU (Executive), Faculty of Architecture and Design / Department of Landscape Architecture, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ersin KARABACAK, Faculty of Arts and Sciences / Department of Biology, Independent Research Project (NAP), Project No: 2480). In this study, plants were classified according to their families; their genus and species names, otorsr' and, when necessary, their varieties were determined. Labels were prepared and attached to the trees for the purpose of introducing the plants in the field. The list of plants determined in Terzioğlu is given in detail in the flora link (Figure 97).

Sea Turtles Research

The <u>Sea Turtle Research and Application Center</u> at our university was established to carry out protection and scientific research to ensure the continuation of the generations of endangered sea turtles and to carry out activities that will increase people's awareness of nature and endangered creatures. The center's activities are carried out in cooperation with other units of our university, the Republic of Turkey, Ministry of Forestry and Water Affairs, General Directorate of Nature Conservation and National Parks, Coast Guard Command, and various national and international civil society organizations.

Lobster Stock Support Program

<u>Lobster Stock Support Program</u>-Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University (ÇOMÜ) Faculty of Marine Sciences and Technologies (DBTF) is implementing the Lobster Stock Support Program. A social responsibility project is being carried out regarding the lobster species, which is overfished due to its economic value. Within the scope of the stock support program, in order to increase the amount of overfished and endangered marine species, the species is first produced on land by human intervention and then their larvae are turned into young individuals and released into the sea (Figure 98).

07.2. Climate Action Plan

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Sustainability Office Coordination Office has prepared the Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Climate Action Plan draft for the 2024-2030 period, which aims to coordinate and direct the implementation of sustainability approaches regarding climate change action throughout the university, and a <u>Climate Action Plan Workshop</u> was held with all stakeholders in line with this draft. In line with this plan, it is aimed to accelerate the monitoring and transformation processes starting from October 2024. <u>The Climate Action Plan</u>, prepared with the contributions of the Sustainability Commission members, outlines the planned activities under the themes of "Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, Transportation, Waste Management, Water Protection, Ecosystems and Biodiversity, Buildings and Infrastructure, Research and Education".

07.3. Waste Management

07.3.1. Zero Waste Application

In order to prevent waste in our country, use natural resources efficiently, reduce waste generation and develop waste separation at source, the <u>Zero Waste application</u> was launched by the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization in 2017. The principles regarding the establishment of the Zero Waste System were specified in detail in the Zero Waste Regulation published in the Official Gazette on July 12, 2019. Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University Terzioğlu Campus received the attached Zero Waste Certificate (Basic Level) in 2021. Our university has a basic level zero waste certificate in Terzioğlu, Biga Ağaköy, University Hospital, Oral and Dental Health Hospital.

Studies and awareness training continue in our campuses with zero waste certificates to operate the system more effectively. Our university has completed the planning stages and started its implementation studies in order to better operate and expand the zero waste system. In this context, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University has prepared a "Zero Waste Project File" in order to receive support from the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change, and received support.

Our university's <u>zero waste website</u> summarizes the work done on waste management. Our university's <u>Zero Waste Directive</u> regulates all the rules that must be followed in the implementation of the Zero Waste Management System in waste management. There is a need for more effective work with stakeholders on all campuses for waste management and for the development of the infrastructure. In addition, work needs to be done on the establishment and dissemination of deposit systems in accordance with the deposit regulation (Figure 99, Figure 100).

07.4. Energy

At Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, solar energy has been applied only on the roof of the Terzioğlu Campus Children's Home (Figure 102). . Our university continues to work for the dissemination of solar energy. In this context, the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate plans to <u>install unlicensed</u> <u>solar power plants for the self-consumption of public institutions</u> such as universities, ministries and hospitals within the scope of the Public and Municipal Renewable Energy Project (KAYEP) supported by the World Bank. In this context, the application phase of the projects prepared for 12 different locations on the campus of our university has been completed and the approval stage has been reached. With the project, the roofs and facades of all buildings of our University and the open parking areas will be transformed into solar power plants. However, it is necessary to disseminate these practices.

07.4.1. Renewable Youth Energy (RE-You) Project

With the Renewable Youth Energy (RE-YOU) project carried out in the Southern Marmara Region, which has the highest renewable energy production potential in Turkey and is quite rich in renewable energy sources such as wind, biogas and solar, 280 hours of both theoretical and practical technical and social skills training were received in the fields of wind, solar and biogas power systems. The Renewable Youth Energy (RE-YOU) Operation is an important project supported within the scope of IPA II within the framework of the Education, Employment and Social Policies Sectoral Operational Program (İKGSOP). The main beneficiary of the project is the Southern Marmara Development Agency, and Balıkesir University and Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University are partners in this project. The budget of this operation, which is determined to have a total duration of 36 months, is approximately 8 million Euros and 85% of this budget is financed by the European Union. The project aims to increase the education and employment opportunities of young people in the field of renewable energy and thus contribute to sustainable development. In this context, laboratories have been established at our university to conduct training and professional qualification exams in the fields of PV, wind and biogas.

On 17.11.2023, the <u>"Renewable Youth Energy Regional Conference"</u> was held at Hilton Hotel Çanakkale within the scope of the RE-You Project (Renewable Youth Energy Operation). The conference, held within the scope of Balıkesir University, Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University and the Renewable Energy Academy (RENAC), where representatives of the private sector and civil society in Turkey's renewable energy sector came together, was held where experts from Europe made presentations on Employment Opportunities, Trainings on Renewable Energy Technologies, and the Personnel Certification System, and sector trends and future cooperation opportunities were evaluated.

07.4.2. Global Wind Organization Approved Basic Safety Training Certificate

Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University Continuing Education Center (COMÜSEM) has received the approval of the authorized institution to provide GWO approved Basic Safety Training (BST). By fulfilling all the requirements, COMÜSEM has earned the title of Training Provider of GWO (Global Wind Organization), a alobal union that aims to create a healthy and safe working environment for all employees in the production. assembly, service and operation processes of the Wind Power Plant (RES) sector. The training aims to provide participants with important skills such as first aid, fire awareness and working at heights. The aim is to gain the necessary competence on the hazards encountered while working in the wind industry and how to control and reduce these hazards, and to provide a fully safe working at height environment with zero work accidents. The training includes ensuring that personnel working in wind power plants and turbines receive Basic Work Safety Trainings required for wind turbines not only at national but also international levels at the same standard. This certification is provided with the capacity building support provided within the Renewable Youth Energy (Re-You) Operation, which was prepared and applied for by the South Marmara Development Agency and was entitled to be supported by the Human Resources Development Sectoral Operational Programme, which is being implemented by the Ministry of Labour and Social Security within the scope of the European Union Pre-Accession Financial Assistance Instrument (IPA).

07.4.3. Individual Carbon Footprint Calculation

A Carbon Footprint button was prepared to raise awareness at Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University, which has the goals of a Nature-Friendly University and Nature-Friendly Campus. The button, which can be accessed by university students and employees via the website and where they can determine their carbon footprint, is available in Turkish and English. The <u>website</u>, which aims to motivate people to make a change in their lifestyle by measuring their daily carbon footprint and is designed as a step in our country's fight against the climate crisis with the slogan "The World is Our Common Home", will be made ready for use as an application in time. Studies have been initiated for the institutional calculation of the carbon footprint. Scope 1 and Scope 2 Carbon Footprints, the data collection system needs to be structured more effectively in order to calculate the carbon footprint, especially on the basis of Scope 3.

07.5. Water usage

The water supply in ÇOMÜ campuses is provided through city water and natural sources. Mains water is mostly used in wet areas in buildings and campuses. Well water is used to irrigate green areas. Information on the clean water consumption amounts of our university is given in the Table 18. The Total Consumption Amount in 2023 was 163,745 m³. It is planned to take measures to reduce water consumption within the scope of the Climate Action Plan. In our university, rainwater harvesting, use of water-saving devices, switching to arid landscaping practices, reducing water consumption from irrigation, and better monitoring of water data should be taken on all campuses.

07.6. Transportation

Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University has 2 large campuses in the central district of Çanakkale, Terzioğlu and Anafartalar Campuses. Students and staff can use the option of bicycle transportation with the Çanakkale Municipality's ÇABİS <u>Smart Bicycle Rental System</u> (Figure 103).

The Anafartalar campus is located very close to the road and is quite suitable for pedestrian and bicycle transportation. However, Terzioğlu Campus has a sloped and rugged structure. Therefore, normal bicycle use is not possible on the campus. However, it is possible for students to come to the campus entrance with their own bicycles or with the ÇABİS system and to reach Terzioğlu Campus with the ring. In addition, ring services need to be increased. In recent years, an increase has been observed in the number of electric bicycles and vehicles. However, there are no electric charging stations on the campus. This deficiency will be eliminated in the coming years. There is a need to work together with stakeholders on all campuses for sustainable transportation.




Interactive Catalog Design of the Faculty of Fine Arts (GSF)



Drone Production

Drone produced by Çanakkale Onskeiz Mart University (ÇOMÜ) Algan Technology Team made its first flight on June 2 at Dardanos Campus. The event started with the flying of the drone, which was designed by the students and whose artificial intelligence and autonomous flight software were produced locally. Algan Technology Team consists of more than 20 students who have all the necessary knowledge about drone construction and are prone to teamwork. The team's 2023 project, A1915, aims to detect forest fires early. The drone vehicle used for this purpose detects smoke and fire with image processing technology and sends notifications to the authorities as soon as these elements are detected. The drone vehicle produced by the Algan Technology Team stands out both among student teams and among other drones in the sector with a flight time of 20 minutes. Capt. 



Art Project with Waste Ceramics for the New Building of Çanakkale Municipality

Free diving world record holder Şahika Ercümen released lobster fry into the depths of the Dardanelles, holding her breath for the lobsters raised by ÇOMÜ. In the second year of the 'Do Good, Throw into the Sea' project implemented by Dardanel and Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University (ÇOMÜ) to increase the local lobster population in order to protect sustainable marine life and marine diversity, 300 baby lobsters were introduced to the sea. Within the scope of the project, studies were carried out to increase the population of the local lobster species 'Homarus gammarus', which is known as the 'European lobster' and is also found in Turkish waters. A successful model in the UK, where this lobster species is produced through aquaculture and released into its natural environment to sustainably support the lobster population in nature, was taken as an example. At the Marine Life Research and Application Center of the Faculty of Marine Sciences and Technology at the Dardanos campus of ÇOMÜ, the team led by Prof. Dr. Umur Önal raised hundreds of baby lobsters from the larval stage in special pools. The program held at Dardanel Mussel Farm in Gallipoli was attended by ÇOMU Rector Prof. Dr. R. Cüneyt Erenoğlu, Dardanel Chairman of the Board of Directors Niyazi Önen, national athlete Şahika Ercümen, academics from ÇOMU Faculty of Marine Sciences and Technology and members of the press.


