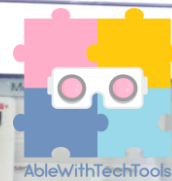

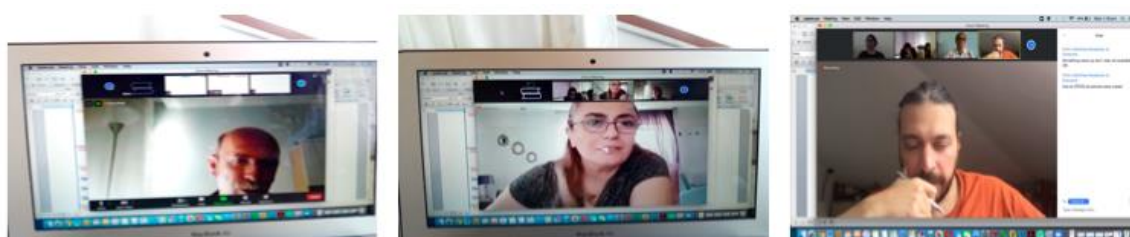
The Second Online Meeting



Developing Virtual Reality Resources Introducing Technology Tools for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder to SEN Teaching Undergraduates

The second online meeting of the “Able with Tech Tools” project was held through Zoom on 15 June 2020.

The meeting lasted two hours and all involved representatives of the partner institutions/organisations participated in the meeting. At the meeting, partners revised the preliminary report at first. This report would be the baseline study of the curriculum. After that, Prof. Dr Hasan Arslan and Dr Nilüfer Çiğdem Umar Kaya (Çanakkale Onsekiz Mart University) made a presentation related to their ongoing studies on the curriculum. Further tasks were scheduled and the voting process (partners would decide by voting 6 assistive technologies to be introduced with the virtual reality technology) for the preparation of the second intellectual output. Next, partners handled the management and dissemination issues. Partners also handled the Covid 19 Pandemic situation and the last regulations of the Turkish National Agency. Partners wanted to clarify some points regarding the organisation of multiplier events and transnational project meetings. The coordinator noted to consult the national agency to give more information to the partners at the next meeting. The partners decided to hold the online meetings once a month (except in August). The social media leg of the project was also handled. Dr Aleksandra Konopka asked partners to introduce the project’s social media page to their networks. The meeting was ended with the health wishes of the partners.



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
